Our mission is to promote child safety and well-being, and to prevent child maltreatment, abuse, and neglect throughout Washtenaw County.

## STAY-at-HOME doesn't necessarily mean SAFE-at-HOME

Child abuse reports have plummeted since COVID-19. The majority of suspected child abuse reports are made by educators, but with kids out of school that means fewer reports. Children are now in homes 24/7 with abusive parents and caregivers, who due to the pandemic are stressed by unemployment and financial worries, and without usual supports. This could mean a large uptick in child abuse cases that are going unreported. But, maybe not unseen or unheard?

# See Something? Hear Something? Say Something

We are asking all adults who may have contact with children during this time, to please report **suspected** child abuse.



Some to watch for: Any signs of distress or mistreatment Pattern bruises or scars Bruises on earlobes Burns - Symmetric immersion/pattern contact Bite marks Persistent poor hygiene Ongoing lack of supervision Consistently inappropriate dress Age-inappropriate knowledge of sexual behavior or sexually explicit behavior Persistent state of hyper alert



Listen for screaming & shouting, or sounds of hitting that seem directed at a child, especially if the parent sounds out of control
